WELFARE

NPF Pensions Limited is the Pension Fund Administrator (PFA) for the welfare enhancement of members of the Police Force. In line with its core mandate of catering to the unique needs of police personnel, NPF PL has achieved the following:

- The recognition of AIG's and above as public office holders who should retire with their full benefits.
- Payment of Retiree Resettlement Support to Police Officers upon retirement whilst awaiting release of their accrued rights.
- Creating pension awareness amongst members of the Police Force by bringing pension services to their doorsteps through our Pension Desk Officers (PDOs)/Customer Service Officers (CSOs) who can be found in all the Police Commands/Formations across the country.

INDUSTRY NEWS

National Pension Commission (PenCom) which is the regulator of the Pension Industry has begun the **'2022 ONLINE VERIFICATION AND ENROLMENT EXERCISE FOR RETIREES/PROSPECTIVE RETIREES OF FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TREASURY-FUNDED MINISTRIES, DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES(MDAs)'** from 20th June,2022 to 31st August,2022.

Those eligible for this exercise are:

- All employees of Federal Government Treasury-Funded MDAs scheduled to retire in 2022.
- All employees of Federal Government Treasury-Funded MDAs who missed the enrolment exercise in previous years.

National Pension Commission (PenCom) has also begun continuation of the Contributor Data Recapture Exercise (DRE) by Pension Fund Administrators (PFAs). This exercise is geared towards having a credible database of all RSA holders in Nigeria.

This exercise is for both active contributors and retirees whose data have not yet been captured in compliance with the Federal Government directive that all data generating organisations should harmonise their databases with the National Identity Management Commission (NIMC).

All NPF PL clients are invited to visit our Pension Desk Officers (PDOs) in their various commands/formations for this exercise.

All our clients who have had a change of name (either their surnames or first names) should visit our PDOs/CSOs in their commands/formations with the necessary documents including:

- Marriage Certificate (in case of marriage)
- Newspaper publication
- Sworn Affidavit
- Confirmation letter for Change of Name from employer.
